

GRADE A UPGRADE: LEBOWAKGOMO VTS SETS A NEW STANDARD FOR ROAD SAFETY– WARD 18

Lepelle-Nkumpi Local Municipality has kicked off the upgrade of the Lebowakgomo Vehicle Testing Station to a Grade A facility - now able to test all vehicle classes, from minibuses to heavy trucks over 3,500 kg, ensuring safer roads for all.

Project Details:

- Start Date: 25 April 2025
- Completion Date: 30 November 2025
- Duration: 6 months
- Budget: R19.9 million
- Jobs Created: 17 local workers (including 7 young people)

Scope of Work:

- Roadbed preparation, kerbs, surfacing, markings, and road signs
- Construction of 0.5 km access paving road
- Parking area with steel shelter
- New building with offices, storerooms, server room
- Ablution facilities for female, male, and people with disabilities
- Two gates with guard houses

This milestone project demonstrates our commitment to road safety, accessibility, and quality service delivery for the people of Lepelle-Nkumpi.
