Requirements

The Municipality will adjudicate and award bids in accordance with the revised PPPFA Regulation and Municipal Supply Chain Management Policy, B-BBEE Level of Contribution on a 80/20 point system, where 80 points will be allocated for price and 20 points will be allocated for B-BBEE Level of Contribution OR on a 90/10 points system, where 90 points will be for price and 10 points for B-BBEF Level of Contribution.

Bidders who do not attend compulsory site briefing will be considered non-responsive and will therefore be disqualified for evaluation. The Municipality reserves the right to negotiate further conditions of the bid and other requirements with the successful bidder and reserves the right to appoint and not to appoint and is not obliged to accept the lowest bid.

All bid documents will be available, upon payment of the non-refundable fee, as from 7 July 2015 from the Supply Chain Management Offices, Unit F, Civic Centre, Lebowakgomo. Bid documents may be collected during working hours (between 07:30 and 15:00 from Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays).

Completed bid documents, fully completed, priced, initiallised on all pages, with certified copies of relevant documents as well as CIDB grading and an original valid tax clearance, sealed in an envelope marked with the bid name, number and description should be deposited in the bid box at Municipal Offices (Civic Centre), Unit F, Lebowakgomo, on or before the closing date at 11:00.

Bids will remain valid for 90 days from the date of closing. No faxed, e-mail bids will be accepted. Service providers using courier services should ensure that their documents are deposited into the bid box. It is not the responsibility of Municipal officials to accept bids from courier services and take to the bid box.
