EVALUATION CRITERIA

All bids received shall be evaluated in terms of the Supply Chain Management Regulations, Lepelle-Nkumpi Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, and other applicable legislations.

- a) The evaluation process consists of the following 3 independent phases –
 - i Phase1: Administration compliance
 - ii, Phase 2: Functionality
 - iii Phase 3: Price and preference.
- b) Bids must meet the requirements of each phase in order to proceed to the next. Only bids that meet the eligibility criteria will be evaluated, and only bids that meet the responsive criteria will be considered for price and preference.
- c) Bids that do not meet the requirements of a particular phase will be disqualified.

1. **RESPONSIVENESS CRITERIA**

The Lepelle-Nkumpi Municipality will consider no Bid unless it meets the following responsiveness criteria:

- The bid must be properly received in a sealed envelope clearly indicating the description of the service and the bid number for which the bid is submitted.
- The bid must be deposited in the relevant bid box as indicated on the notice of the bid on or before the closing date and time of the bid.
- Pin/ Valid Tax Clearance Certificate must be submitted with the bid.
- Bid document must be completed in full.
- **All Pages must be initialized or signed.**
- Alterations must be signed or initialized.
- Copy of the company registration certificate must be submitted with the bid.
- Certified copy of BBBEE Certificate or original sworn affidavit must also be attached.
- Certified copy of Identity document (ID) for all the director(s) must be attached
- Submission of a Joint Venture Agreement, where applicable, which has been properly signed by all parties.
- Complies with the requirements of the bid and technical specifications.
- Authority for signatory - attach resolution in case of more than one director.

28. Recovery of rates in arrears from tenants and occupiers

- (1) If an amount due for rates levied in respect of a property is unpaid by the owner of the property after the date determined in terms of section 26(2), the municipality may recover the amount in whole or in part from a tenant or occupier of the property, despite any contractual obligation to the contrary on the tenant or occupier. The municipality, may recover an amount only after the municipality has served a written notice on the tenant or occupier.
- (2) The amount a municipality may recover from the tenant or occupier of a property in terms of subsection (1) is limited to the amount of the rent or other money due and payable, but not yet paid, by the tenant or occupier to the owner of the property.
- (3) Any amount a municipality recovers from the tenant or occupier of the property must be set off by the tenant or occupier against any money owed by the tenant or occupier to the owner.
- (4) The tenant or occupier of a property must, on request by a municipality, furnish the municipality with a written statement specifying all payments to be made by the tenant or occupier to the owner of the property for rent or other money payable on the property during a period determined by the municipality.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Background Information

Lepelle-Nkumpi Municipality is one of the municipalities within the Capricorn District Municipality in Limpopo Province and is located in the Southern part of the district and include Lebowakgomo Township.

The Municipality is currently seeking for an experienced and qualified Service Provider to perform Cash Management Services to three collection offices, namely; Civic Centre and two Satellite offices.

2. Mandatory Requirements

2.1. Armoured Vehicles

3. Scope of Work

3.1 Details regarding Collection Process

3.1.1 Collection of sealed containers from the following points:

- Civic Centre, Stand no. 170BA Lebowakgomo.(next to Lebowakgomo complex)
- Municipal Satellite office, Zone A (next to Shopping Centre)About 6 kilometres from Civic Centre
- Municipal Traffic station, Mamaolo- About 3 kilometres from Zone A Satellite Office

3.1.2 Collection must be done during week days (i.e. Monday to Friday) at 15h30. Municipal offices are closed during week-ends and public holidays.

- Notification will be made to the Service Provider for the normal working days at which municipal offices will be closed.

3.1.3 Cash must be transported and banked in the municipal bank account in Polokwane on the same day or the following day after collection.

3.1.4 The Service Provider must be able to supply two **Electronic Cash Acceptance devices** to be utilized at both the Civic Centre and the Municipal Traffic Station.

The device must have the following features:

- Note Capacity: Up to 2500 notes
- Bulk note feeder validator
- Heat seal tamper evident bags
- Counter/Processing Speed: 60 notes per minute

- Numeric keypad
- Keypad pin security

3.1.5 Bank deposits slips shall be returned to the municipality in the next working day after deposits have been made.

4. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Variations

- 4.1 The municipality reserves the right to amend the frequencies, pattern, number and/or location of deliveries at any time during the contract upon providing the Service Provider with seven (7) days' notice. Such variation shall not normally provide grounds for any increases in the prices applicable to the schedule concerned, unless the variation requested can be demonstrated to have a significant and material impact upon the Service Provider.

4 Professional Indemnity Insurance

The Service Provider must have Insurance cover at a minimum value of R500 000 (Five hundred thousand rand) whereupon proof must be submitted to the Municipal Manager within thirty (30) days.

5. Charges

There shall be no charges to the municipality in addition to those charges tendered by the Service Provider.

6 Failure to carry out collection

- 6.1 In the event that a Service Provider is unable to make a collection from any collection point, then he shall notify the location concerned sufficiently early to permit alternative arrangements to be made. The municipality will therefore not become liable for charges during the period of non-collection.
- 6.2 Additional costs incurred because of the Supplier's failure to provide the service shall be recoverable from the Supplier. This charge shall apply whether or not prior warning of the failure to collect or deliver has been provided.

7 Payment

CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- 1 This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids¹ invited.
- 2 Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).² Collusive bidding is a *per se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.
- 3 Municipal Supply Regulation 38 (1) prescribes that a supply chain management policy must provide measures for the combating of abuse of the supply chain management system, and must enable the accounting officer, among others, to:
