

UPGRADING OF KHURENG VILLAGE 4.2 KM INTERNAL ROAD FROM GRAVEL TO TAR AND STORMWATER SYSTEM – WARD 02

Residents of Lepelle-Nkumpi Local Municipality (LNM) continue to benefit from quality infrastructure. Development of infrastructure enhances mobility, safety, and service delivery.

The upgrading of 4.2 km internal road and storm-water system in Ward 02, Khureng Village, Zebediela cluster is progressing well, and currently at 60% completion. A total of 18 local workers, of which 10 are young people and 01 disabled persons, have been recruited, helping to boost local employment.

The project details are as follows: contract value of the multi-year project is R37 million, with a start date of 19 November 2024, and a planned completion date of 25 August 2025, which is a duration of eight (8) months.

The scope of work includes upgrading the road from gravel to tar, installation of adequate drainage infrastructure, road markings, and signage. Upon completion, the upgraded road will form a ring road that encompasses the entire village of Khureng.

This project represents a significant investment in the infrastructure and well-being of Khureng Village. Furthermore, an upgrade of this crucial internal road will benefit the community in terms of safety, accessibility, and overall quality of life.
