

McKenzie sends six snubbed Bafana players to World Cup opener

Sport, arts and culture minister Gayton McKenzie has secured a partnership to fly the six players dropped from Hugo Broos's final squad to Mexico, ensuring they can watch Bafana Bafana's opening match against the co-hosts on June 11.

Brandon Petersen, Thabiso Monyane, Patrick Maswanganyi, Thapelo Morena, Lebohang Maboe and Brooklyn Poggenpoel were devastated last week during a presidential dinner when they

were cut from the official 26-man Fifa World Cup squad.

McKenzie announced that SA clothing brand, Old School, has stepped in to fully sponsor the players' travel and accommodation costs. He said the six deserved to be at the tournament as they were part of SA's qualification journey.

"These six men trained, sacrificed and prepared with the same dedication as every player in that squad. They were part of this journey," McKenzie said.

"The margin between making the final

cut and missing out on a World Cup is razor-thin, and it would be wrong for that margin to mean their contribution simply disappears. They deserve to be there, and they deserve to see what they helped build."

While Broos faced backlash over how the exclusions were handled, McKenzie defended the

Belgian mentor, acknowledging that he had to make a tough decision.

"Broos had to make impossible choices this week, and we accept this. It is the nature of sport; disappointment for some is the inescapable flip side of glory for others."
